

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Babylon PTSA is proud to offer scholarships each year to deserving Babylon High School seniors who plan to continue their education.

Minimum Criteria. Check each box below to verify that you meet the minimum qualifications.

- Current enrollment as a full time senior at Babylon High School.
- Current member of the Babylon PTSA by March 2nd of the current school year.
- Good citizenship as demonstrated by no ISS or OSS suspensions at Babylon High School.
- Progress toward graduation with appropriate credits to graduate on time.

Additional Criteria.

- A minimum of 30 volunteer hours total to their school and/or community from freshman through senior year. With some hours focusing on PTSA volunteer activities.
- (2) References.
- Demonstrated commitment in at least two or more of the following areas (through school, community organizations and/or employment): academics, the arts, athletics, service or employment.
- Essay (see below).
- Applicant must enroll in a post-secondary school and provide the Babylon PTSA Treasurer with official notification of enrollment before funds will be released.

Essay. Please answer the following question in essay typed format. Please do not exceed one typed page. **Do NOT include your name on or in your essay answer.** Grammar and spelling count; so check your work.

What have you done during your high school years to give back and contribute to our local community?

Please describe in detail the types of volunteer work, local community service, activities or employment in which you have been involved. Include your specific contributions; any initiatives you took; amount of time invested; the role you played; and impact of your efforts. This may include extra-curricular activities in the arts, athletics, work experience or academics.

Deadline for completed application submission is Friday, March 2, 2018.

Note: Financial need is NOT a part of the application process; this is a merit scholarship.
