In an effort to help support your student's dream of higher education, Suffolk Federal in partnership with Suffolk County Community College, is now offering local high-school seniors a chance to win scholarships for college. Scholarships are administered under the auspices of the Suffolk Community College Foundation, Inc. Below are the scholarships that are available to Suffolk County's college-bound high school seniors. Through this program and partnership, six scholarships will be awarded ranging from \$6,275 to \$12,550.

**1) Suffolk Federal Scholarship**

**Award: \$6,275 each** (\$3,275 will be awarded to recipients in the fall of 2020 and \$3,000 will be awarded to the recipients in the spring of 2021). Four scholarships available.

- Recipient must be a member of Suffolk Federal at the time of the award.
- Minimum High School GPA of 77
- Demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activity and/or community service.
- Student must be a resident of Suffolk County.
- Student must submit an essay of no more than 250 words explaining their eligibility and how they will benefit from receiving this scholarship.

**2) The Michael E. Reilly Memorial Scholarship**

**Award: \$6,275 to a new full-time student.** (\$3,275 will be awarded to the recipient in the fall of 2020 and \$3,000 will be awarded to the recipient in the spring 2021). One scholarship available.

- Recipient must be a member of Suffolk Federal at the time of the award.
- Must have a family member who is a volunteer of a Suffolk County Fire Department or local EMS
- Student must be a resident of Suffolk County.
- Student must submit an essay of no more than 250 words explaining their eligibility and how they will benefit from receiving this scholarship, along with details of their personal connection to having a family member of a local fire department or EMS.

**3) LT Michael P. Murphy Memorial Scholarship**

**Award: \$12,550.** (\$6,275 will be awarded to the recipient during the 2020-2021 academic year and \$6,275 will be awarded to the same recipient during the 2022-2022 academic year). One scholarship available.

- Recipient must be a member of Suffolk Federal at the time of the award.
- Minimum High School GPA of 77

- Demonstrated involvement in a school sport, extracurricular activity or involvement at a community-based organization.
- Student must be a resident of Suffolk County.
- Student must submit an essay of no more than 250 words explaining their eligibility and how they will benefit from receiving this scholarship.
