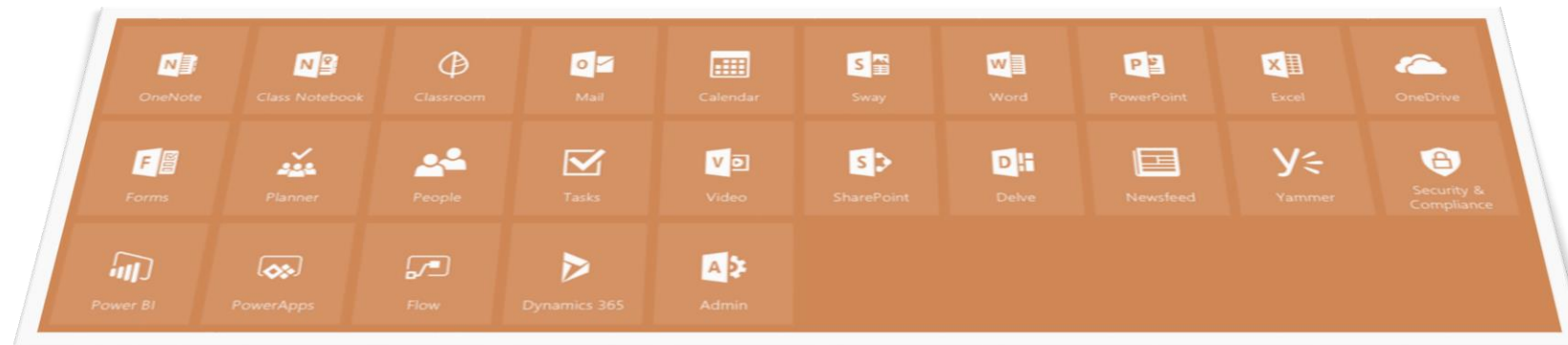

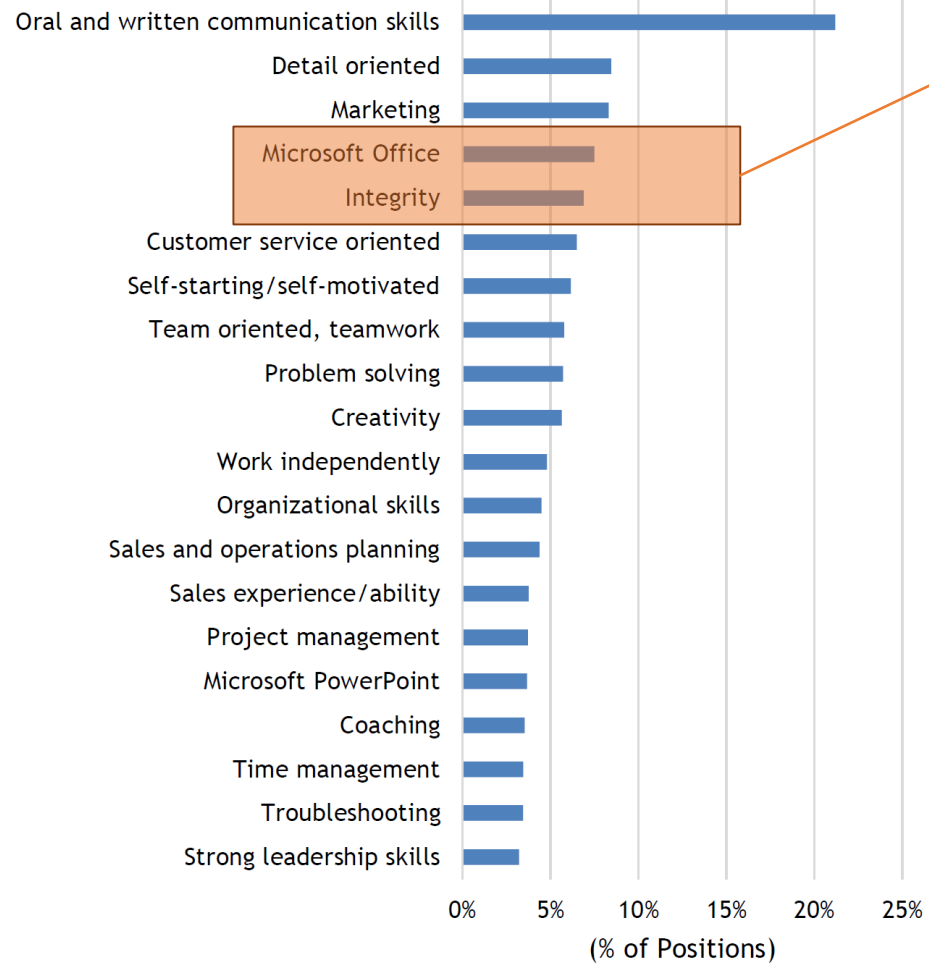

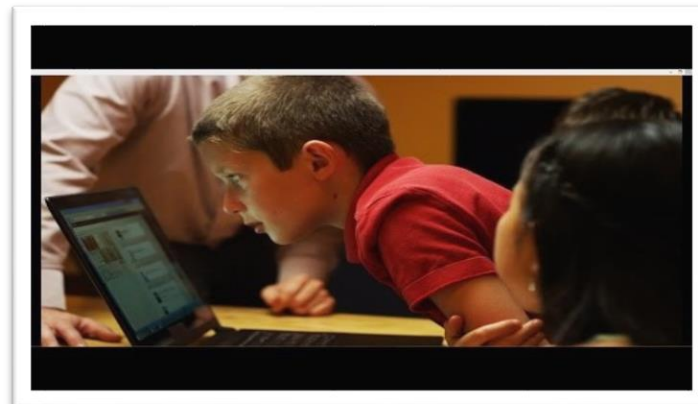

Expenditure Review:

Detailed review of specific budgeted items
Resubmitted after revisions with expenditures

Review Board:

Sent to SUNY for review of relevant professional development and collaboration with teacher preparation programs and DOB for complete review

Approved:

District can begin to make expenditures consistent with approved plan
